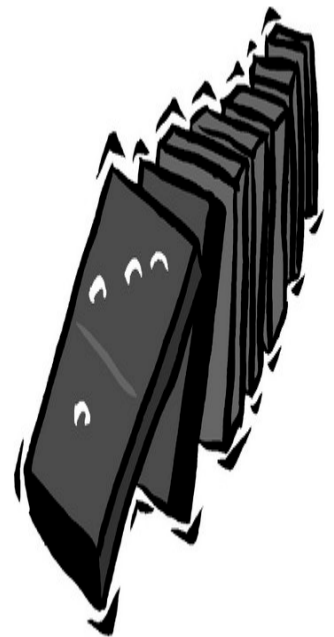
### Did you know?

- approximately half of nursing home residents fall every year, with many of these residents falling more than once.
